The apparatus shown gave the most convincing evidence of the *unquantum effect*. Gamma rays from the annihilation of matter and antimatter, were measured to defy quantum chance by a factor of 900. The photo is looking inside a low noise chamber made with three inch thick lead. See chapter on *Particle Violation Spectroscopy* for details of this experiment. The wave pattern depicts the double slit experiment, a statement of the paradox. The resolution of the paradox is the *loading theory* of how discrete photoelectron events can take place.
